  - HSA vendor vetting is still in process. Questions for the committee:

    - How should we approach future HSA work over the summer when BFC discussions break. How to keep communication open?
      - We could send a memo to current and incoming BFC presidents as well as the BFC office.

- Marathon Health updates
  - Expansion process is complete and patients have been using some of additional offices closer to regional campuses and out of state locations as well. Numbers overall are increasing. Majority of uses are for preventative health and numbers are increasing for mental health services as well. May is mental health month and information will be sent out about resources available. Healthy IU will also be sending out information about summer programs available. IU HR is working on gathering narratives on use of Marathon Health to remind employees about referral services available. There are great stories to share with the BFC in the fall to demonstrate impact and return on investment.
